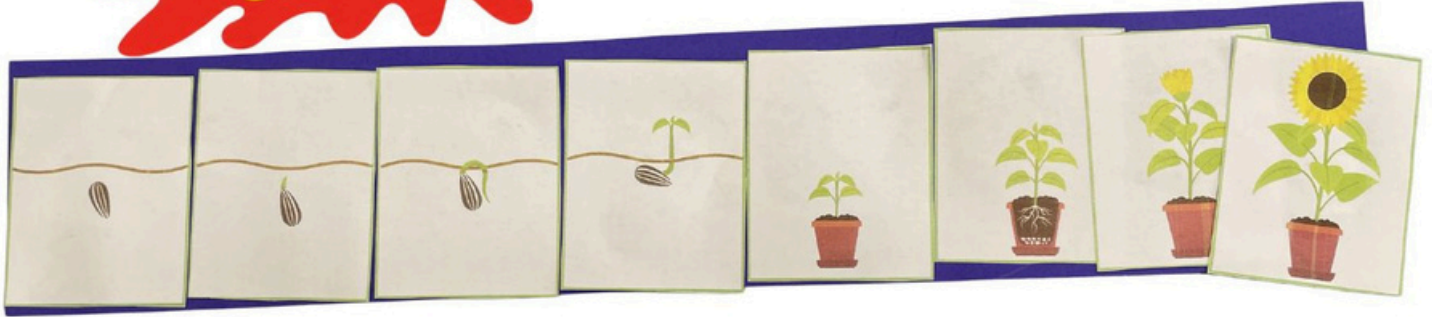
ADULT FELLOWSHIP
