REST IN PEACE DAVID



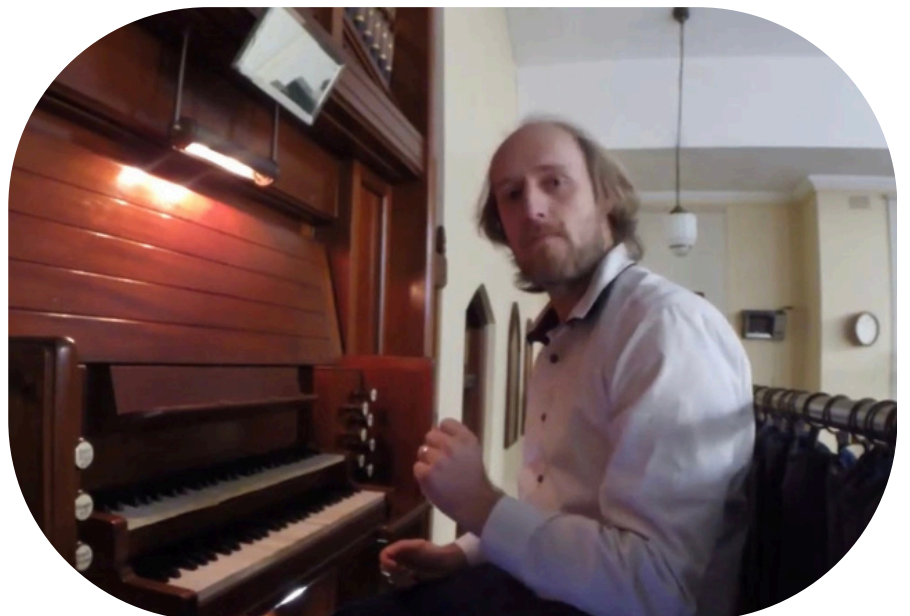
